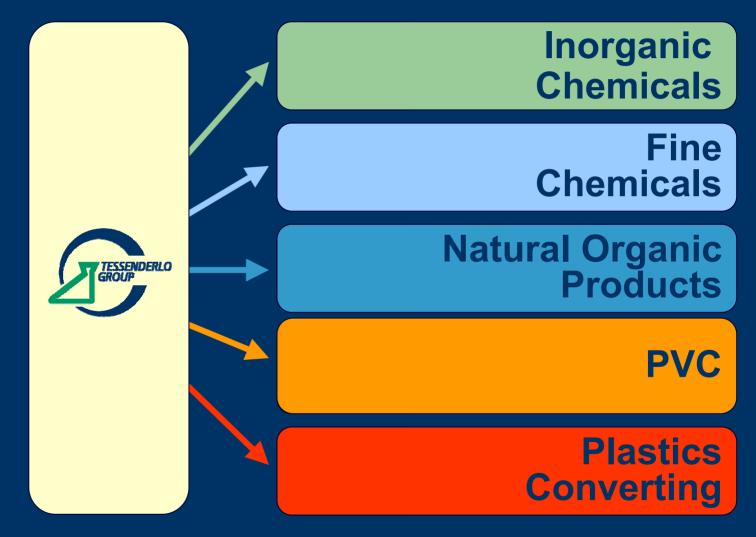

- About 8,000 employees achieving consolidated sales of 1,934 million EUR in 2002.

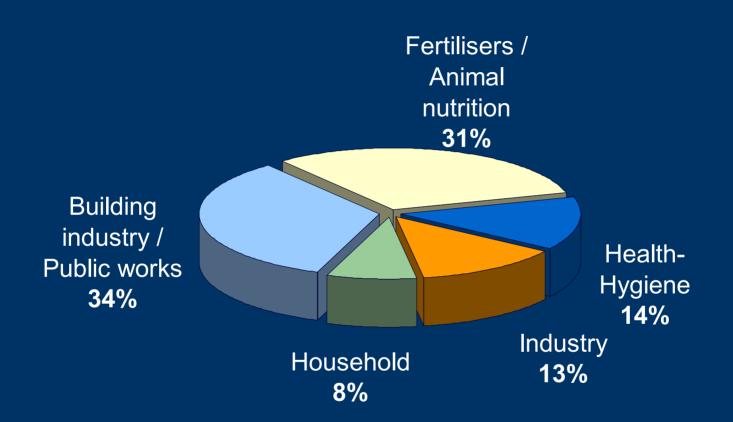

History



- **1892** First chemical activities in Tessenderlo
- 1919 Founding of *Produits Chimiques de Tessenderlo* to manufacture sulphate of potash (fertiliser) and hydrochloric acid
- 1929 Entrance of French capital
- 1930 Appr. 1,000 members of staff
 80% of the production is exported
- 1964 Gelatin production is introduced
- 1972 Start production VCM
- 1976 Entry into the Fine Chemicals market
- 1984 Start development Plastics Converting
- 1995 Further global expansion (China, USA, Brasil, Argentina,...)

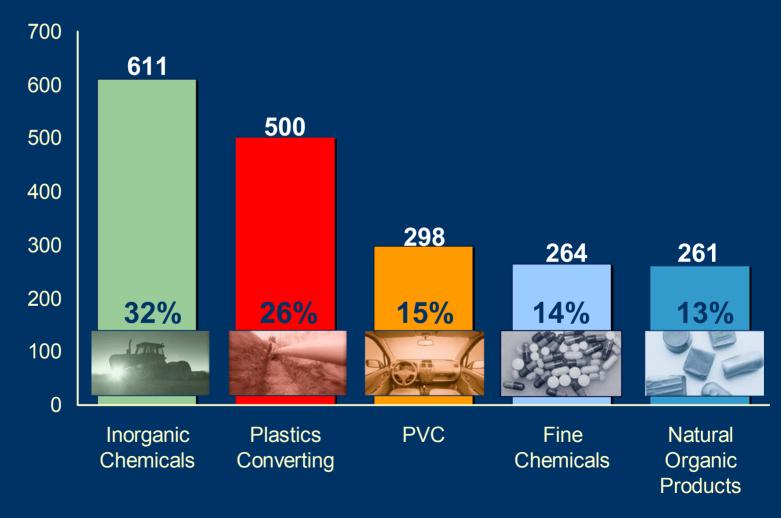

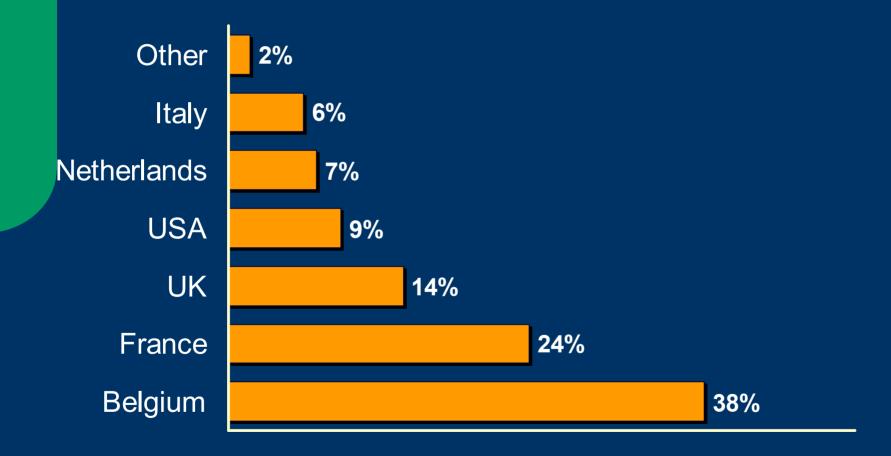


Sales Breakdown (2002 - millions EUR)



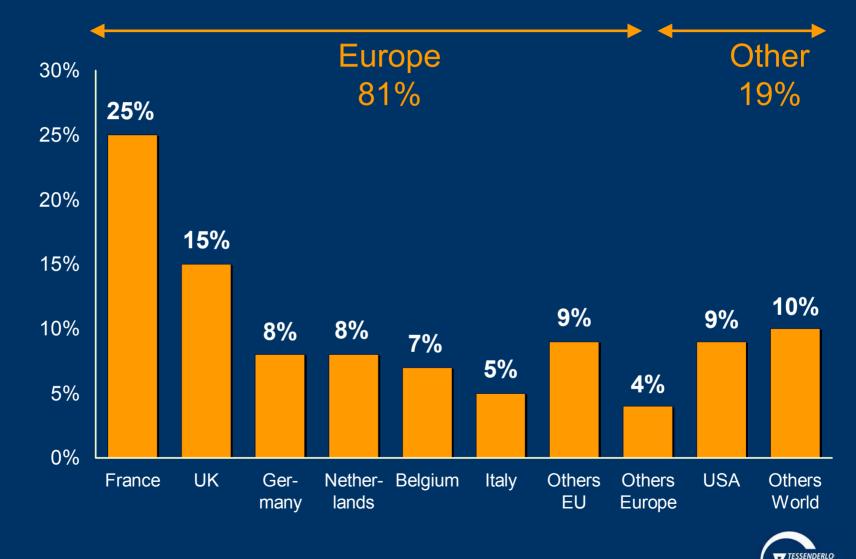


Turnover by Country of Production (year 2002)

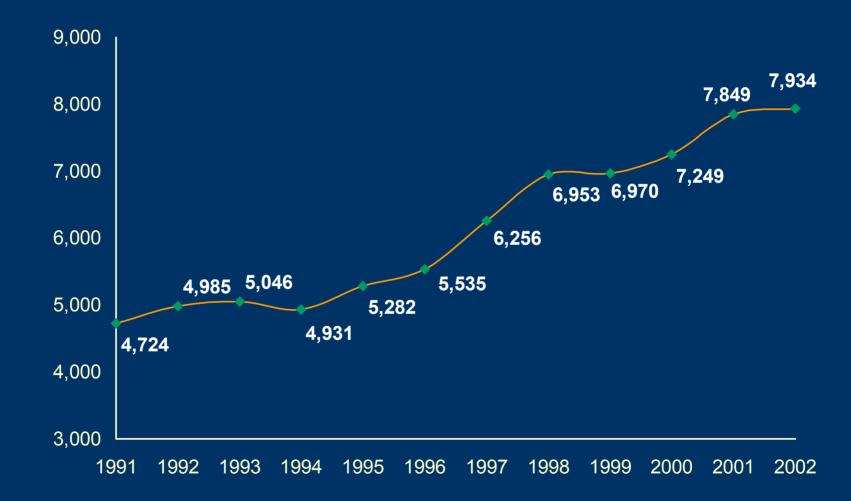




Turnover by Country of Destination (year 2002)

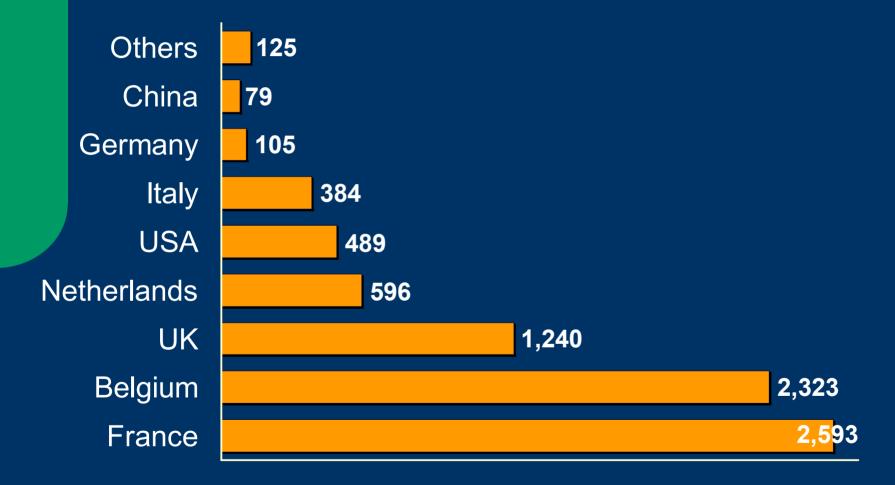

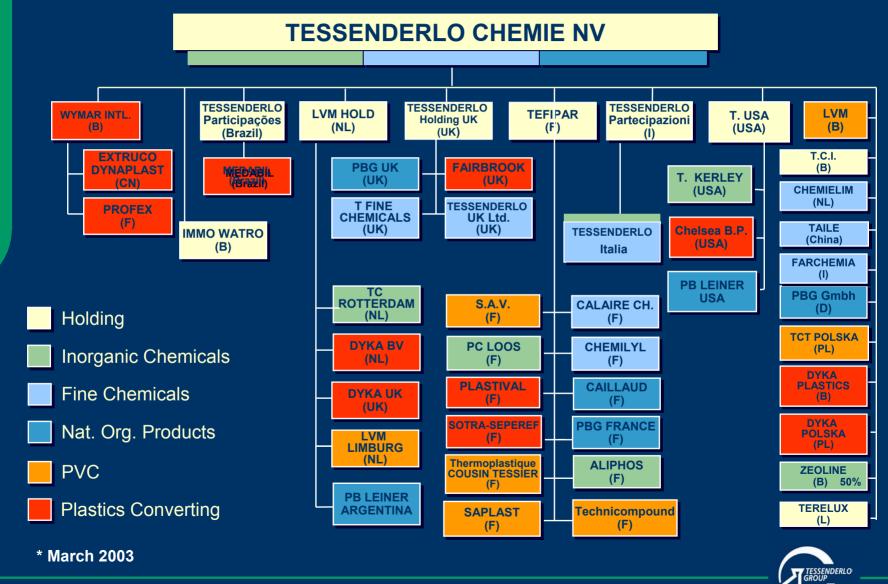


Employment Breakdown per Country (year 2002)



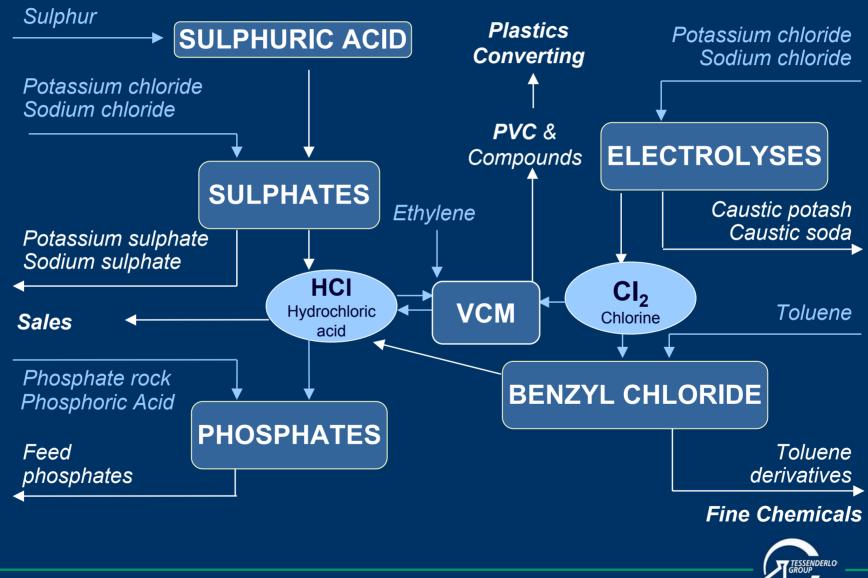

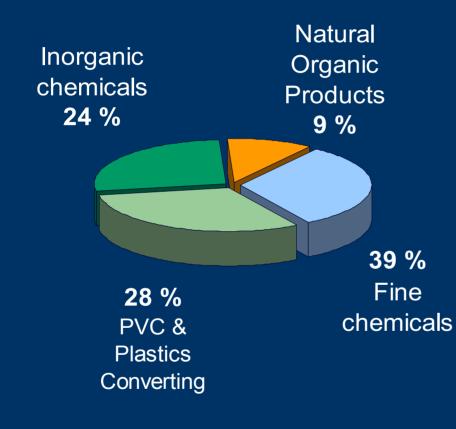
