This is a reflection of how the region is poised to lead the global plastic industry in the next five years. Recent surveys have also indicated that Saudi Arabia has the highest per capita consumption of plastics in the Middle East with an astounding 40 kilograms per person, which is twice as much as any other country in the GCC.

In addition, rising income and a growing population continue to fuel demand within the food and beverage and consumer goods sectors, burgeoning & at full blast at this stage. Consequently the demand for plastic is drastically rising in:

- Food and beverage packaging
- Household goods
- Consumer goods
- Construction materials
- Medical Plastic

This provides impetus for growth and vast business opportunities for those engaged in plastics manufacturing and related industries.

By 2015, the Kingdom will produce about 100 million tons per year of petrochem products making it the largest player in the world

The past ten years' growth of the energy-based industries in the Kingdom (such as steel, fertilizers and petrochemicals) suggests that the KSA will become as dominant in the Petrochemical sector, as it is presently in the Petroleum one.

Indeed, petrochem is witnessing an unmatched growth, as multi-billion dollar investments are being made in the Kingdom's infrastructure.






Number of direct exhibitors
